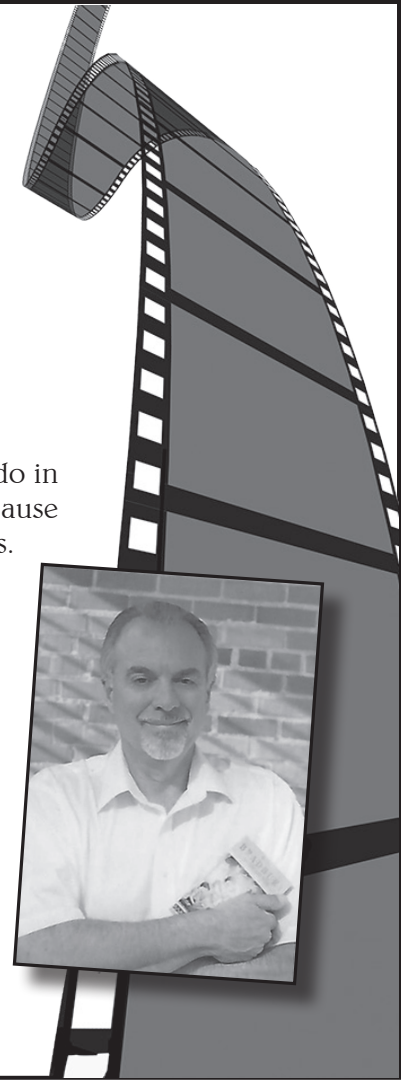
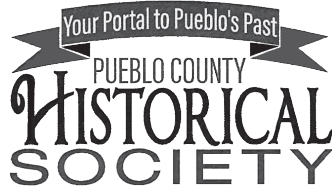

The Historic Films of the Pikes Peak Region

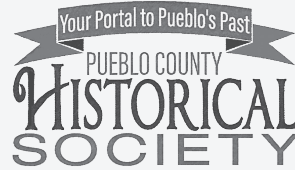
This program features the historic films that were shot in Southern Colorado in the past 120 years. Colorado has a rich history of films produced in the state because of the scenic beauty of the area which made a natural backdrop for filmmakers.

Steve Antonuccio retired from the Pikes Peak Library District in 2008. He helped acquire the collection of historic films for the Pikes Peak Library during his 20 year career managing the Library Channel. He wrote an academic paper on the Alexander Film Company for the Pikes Peak Regional History Symposium in 2012. Steve moved to Pueblo in 2009 and managed the Barkman Branch and Pueblo West libraries. He published a book in 2019 on his career working in libraries entitled *There Is No Such Thing as a Typical Librarian*.
